

FV'S OTORHINOLARYNGOLOGY DEPARTMENT PROVIDE SUCCESSFUL TREATMENTS FOR

RARE TONGUE SQUAMOUS CELL CARCINOMA



Following the biopsy, a CT scan of the face and neck was requested to investigate the tumour in the tongue and neck area. The imaging findings showed a tongue tumour and several enlarged cervical lymph nodes. Combining CT with the biopsy results allowed the doctor to identify squamous cell cancer T2N0M0 that would require surgery for treatment.

After a week, the patient underwent general anaesthesia for surgery. First, Dr Pham Long Dao treated the tongue tumour and cut 0.5 cm of skin from the edge of the ulcer and sent the specimen for a frozen section at the FV Laboratory. This helped to ensure that the entire tumour is removed while preserving the optimal of tongue as possible.

At the same time, while waiting for the results of the frozen section result, Dr Dao and his team continued and remove the lymph nodes in the neck region, selecting groups from 1A to 4.

The frozen section results were available after 45 minutes and about 0.5 cm from the edge of the specimen, which has was clear of the presence of cancer cells. With a small tumour size and dilatation at the back, the doctor chose the solution to suture that area as the tongue surface did not need reconstruction. The operation was completed after 4 hours and the patient was discharged 4 days later. Currently, Ms D.T.L.P health is completely stable and she can eat and talk normally.

According to Dr Pham Long Dao, tongue cancer is a malignant tumour that originates in the mobile or fixed part of the tongue (bottom of the tongue). This is a common type of cancer and accounts for about 30%-50% of cancers of the oral cavity. Selective neck lymphadenectomy is indicated if the risk of lymph node metastasis exceeds 15 to 20% and is usually performed for patients with stage T2 tongue cancer.
