Scoring: The final results will be decided by the judging panel based on three main criteria:

Content: 40%Design: 30%

The best designs will be showcased at the Closing Ceremony on 19 September and awarded with attractive prizes:

• **1st Prize:** 2,000,000 VND

• 2nd Prize (2 winners): 1,000,000 VND each
